Signed, Sealed, To be Delivered

Bordelon Marine has signed a contract with Bibby Subsea for the upcoming vessel Brandon Bordelon.

In January Bibby Subsea announced that they had signed a three year contract with Bordelon Marine to charter the Brandon Bordelon. The Brandon Bordelon, the third in the Stingray series is an ultra-light intervention vessel (ULIV) and will commence a three year charter in August 2015 upon delivery of the vessel from shipyard. The vessel will primarily operate in the Gulf of Mexico. The Brandon Bordelon continues the evolution of the Stingray series vessels by offering a 260' DP2 vessel with a 60 ton AHC crane and features a helideck. The vessel will house two work class ROV's with (60) sixty total bunks. Signing a long term charter agreement with Bibby Subsea for the Brandon Bordelon confirms Bor-

delon Marine as a provider of subsea vessels for complex offshore operations, including IMR operations (inspection, maintenance and repair), light construction, survey and inspection work. With our valued partners Bibby Subsea, Bordelon Marine establishes a strong presence in the subsea community.
